Your name must appear on the precinct list in the district where you reside by September 1, 2024 to be qualified to vote. If you are not sure if you are registered in this district, contact the Borough Clerk at 907-874-2381 Ext. 5 or email clerk@wrangell.com. Here are the qualification for voter registration:

- 1. a United States citizen; and
- 2. registered and qualified to vote in the State of Alaska elections and registered thereat for at least thirty (30) days immediately preceding the municipal election; and
- 3. at least eighteen (18) years of age; and
- 4. a resident of the City & Borough of Wrangell for thirty (30) days preceding the election; and
- 5. not disqualified by reason of having been convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude, and if so, that civil rights have been restored, nor disqualified because judicially determined to be of unsound mind.
