The City and Borough of Wrangell reserves the right to modify the contract after its award.

QUALITY OF WORK. All materials shall conform to the specifications, industry standards and practices, and the manufacturer's requirements.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES. Liquidated damages are \$250.00 per calendar day for each day past the scheduled contract delivery dates.

IMMATERIAL DIFFERENCES. The City & Borough of Wrangell reserves the right to determine whether equipment that complies substantially in quality and performance with the specifications are acceptable, and whether any variance listed by the Bidder in a bid is material or immaterial.

### EVALUATION OF BIDS AND SELECTION AND AWARD

- 1. Successful Bidder will be determined by the Evaluation Ranking as indicated in Part 3 of the solicitation. Awards will not be made based on price alone. The City & Borough of Wrangell reserves the right to arrange for discussions and demonstrations to assist in the evaluation of bids. Award will be made to the responsive and responsible Bidder whose Bid is determined to be most advantageous to the City & Borough of Wrangell.
- 2. The Criteria and Evaluation Form is listed under Part 2 of this solicitation. In Bidder's Proposal, under Column 2 of this form, the Bidder shall respond to each minimum requirement listed in Column 1, Technical Specifications (Minimum). If necessary, a separate sheet may be used for description. When asked to "describe", the description may include details such as size, capacities, dimensions, materials used in construction, etc. A full and complete description is required to reasonably evaluate the bid, so all pertinent information is required. When referring to attached literature as a means of not fully describing items, misinterpretations by the evaluator of the bid may occur and consequently not having the bid awarded.
- 3. 1.2 SCOPE OF WORK. The City & Borough of Wrangell is requesting bids for the procurement of one Genie Articulated Manlift (Boom).

## 1.3 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. All equipment bid shall be new or used and shall fall within the production models and age listed in the technical specifications. Brochures and/or specification literature, which clearly describes the proposed equipment and verifies that the equipment meets or exceeds the requirements of this specification, should accompany each bid proposal. Any manufacturer's name and model called out in this bid is intended to set the quality and design of equipment desired and is not meant to limit bidding on products of equal quality. Any exceptions to or deviations from the specifications set forth in the bid must be clearly described in the Bidder's Proposal.
- B. Current photos of the equipment shall be submitted with the bid to document clearly the make and model, hour meter, accessories, and general condition of the equipment.

### 1.4 DELIVERY

## PART 3.5 SCORING AND RANKING METHODOLOGY.

Committee members will score responses independently:

## A. Points:

- 1. Members will assign point to each Bidder, 0 through 5 (5 being the highest score), for each criteria. Points may be assigned as whole numbers or fractions, i.e. 1.0, 1.7, 3.75, 4.5, etc.
- 2. Members points for each evaluation criteria will be multiplied by the criteria weight resulting in a total score. The total score obtainable is 500.

## B. Scores:

- 1. Members' evaluation criteria scores for each Bidder will be added together for a total score and final ranking.
- 2. The highest total score will receive a ranking of 1; the 2nd highest total score will receive a ranking of 2, and so on.
- C. The Members will meet to discuss the responses, scoring, and any other issues related to the project. Members have an option to either:

- 1. Adjust their scoring based on the their discussion;
- 2. Re-rank respondents based on their discussion; or
- 3. Determine a scoring by the consensus of the Members.
- D. The Members may prepare a "shortlist" of highest scored Bidder's depending on the number of Bidders and analysis of the final scoring.

## PART 3.6 DISCUSSION AND DEMONSTRATIONS

- A. After reviewing submissions, the Borough may request discussion or interviews with either the short listed or top ranked Bidder(s) to further clarify the Borough's requirements, the Bidder's response and/or request additional information. Therefore, the Bidder shall have officials of the appropriate management level present and representing the firm, if a presentation is scheduled by the Borough. All costs associated with the presentation shall be borne by the Bidder.
- B. All equipment included in the Bid is subject to a performance demonstration at the discretion of the Borough, within 30 days of the bid date. A like item of the type bid that contains all the safety concerns, horsepower ratings, accessories, dimensions or other features as deemed appropriate by the City & Borough of Wrangell may be required to be demonstrated to Borough personnel prior to award of the bid in order to establish that the item meets the requirements and specifications. These demonstrations may be held in direct competition with other vendors who bid the same or similar equipment. All costs associated with the Bidder's demonstration shall be borne by the Bidder. All travel costs by Borough personnel shall be borne by the Borough.
